PEACEFUL WALLS

Finished Quilt approx 64 x 72

Scripture: *May there be peace within your walls and security within your citadels."*
Psalm 122:7

Fabric Requirements:

Bricks (color 1)	1 1/8 yard	Borders	1 yard
Bricks (color 2)	1 1/8 yard	Binding	1/2 yard
Squares (color 1)	1 yard	Backing	3 1/2 yards
Squares (color 2)	1 yard		

NOTE: Directional fabrics not recommended for this quilt.

CUTTING:

Bricks (1) Fabric, cut four 8 1/2" strips. Cut strips into 28 4 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles.

Bricks (2) Fabric, cut four 8 1/2" strips. Cut strips into 28 4 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles.

Squares (1) Fabric cut eight 4 1/2" strips

Squares (2) Fabric cut eight 4 1/2" strips

Border Fabric cut 8 4 1/2" strips – set aside so as not to confuse them with the Bricks

Binding Fabric cut 7 2 1/2" strips

PIECING

Sew each of the Squares Fabric 1 & 2 together using one Fabric (1) and one Fabric (2) on each strip set. These should measure 8 1/2" Make 8 strip sets. Press toward the darker fabric



From these strip sets, cut into 4 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles making a total of 56 units.

PEACEFUL WALLS

Sew one of these units to one of the rectangles from “Bricks” cut above. You will have 56 units – 28 of each color. These should measure 8 ½” square when completed.



Following diagram, sew units together into 8 rows of 7 blocks, alternating brick colors. Press seams toward Brick Fabric. Sew 8 rows together matching seams.



Press entire quilt. Measure the size of the quilt from side to side. Piece 2 borders to this measurement. Pin border to quilt top at both ends and in the center. Sew into place. Add bottom border following this procedure.

Now measure quilt from top to bottom including borders. Piece 2 more borders to this measurement. Following same procedure, attach borders to quilt.



Measure size of completed quilt top and cut/piece backing making it a little larger than quilt top. Sandwich and quilt as desired.

Measure the perimeter of entire quilt. Sew binding strips together equaling this measurement plus 10”. Apply binding using your favorite method.
